Introduction

Standard print functionality in Lotus Notes applications is characterized by reproducing a document's data field values. At its best this can print Rich Text Fields with the format of the data therein. This has serious shortcomings when printouts need to include other content such as watermarks, headers, footers and even other graphics. In these situations a different approach is required.

What is i-Print?

i-Print is the i-seven add-on for producing customized printouts from Lotus Notes applications.

i-Print provides a plethora of functionality for including dynamic data objects such as graphics, barcodes, special font types and more. This means that prints of documents can match corporate styles and business-specific needs. It does this by allowing:

- ▶ **Fonts** – built upon definable point sizes, widths and heights.
- ▶ **Watermarks and banners.**
- ▶ **Headers and footers.**
- ▶ **Geometric shapes** – lines, arcs, rectangles, triangles and ellipses.
- ▶ **Graphics** – from document attachments, application resources or directory files.

Furthermore, **i-Print** functionality can also determine the properties of print objects, allowing for logically bound and conditional print relationships.

More than just document printing

Labels can also easily be printed using the provided industry-standard label definitions. And if this is not enough, new label formats can be added and made available to application users. Label content is created by using document field names in stored routines. This allows creation of a library of label printing alternatives, for example for addresses, product markers, barcodes and even business cards to mention but a few.

Flexible output alternatives

i-Print includes special features for managing printer setup, for example selecting a specific printer for a print job, ensuring printer adjustment for true reproduction and forcing page breaks where necessary. Printer-related resources can be cleared when the print job has completed, allowing these to be used for other computing tasks. Besides using a printer, **i-Print** can provide on-screen previewing and document saving as a PDF file. Printing is even possible from a web browser using ActiveX controls.

A complete package

i-Print provides you with a set of printing capabilities that can be used from Lotus Script. The more than 30 print-related functions can be quickly applied in application agents and made available to users, for example from toolbars, menus or other application accessible objects.
